## ADMISSIONS AND ELIGIBILITY

- Students seeking admission to any class are required to follow the proper admission procedure.
- Students who have passed ICSE/ CBSE or any Board/ University outside the Maharashtra State will have to obtain a Certificate of Eligibility from the Divisional Secretary, Maharashtra State Secondary & Higher Secondary Education Board, Vashi.
- Students seeking admission, have to produce a valid Leaving certificate from the School or College last attended by him/ her at the time of admission.
- As per the rules of the Education Department, Government of Maharashtra, no student is allowed to take admission to two courses simultaneously.
- A student seeking admission from any Junior College during the Second Term must produce a "No Objection Certificate" from the Principal of the Junior College last attended by him / her.
- A student seeking admission should have more than 40% in Science in the S.S.C. Examination to be eligible for taking admission in Science Stream.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

### Conduct and Discipline:

- After admission, every student will be given an Identity Card. Students not wearing the Identity Card will not be allowed to enter the college.
- The prescribed uniform is to be worn by the students at all times when in the College Campus and when representing the College.
- Students must maintain silence in the classrooms, library, reading room and corridors especially when lectures are going on in the adjoining rooms.
- Students should not be seen in the canteen, corridors or around the college premises during their lecture timings.
- Students must take proper care of the college property and help in keeping the premises neat and clean. They must not write on the blackboard or disfigure the walls, tables or benches. Any wilful damage to the college property will be considered and dealt with as a breach of discipline.
- Ragging is prohibited as per the decision of Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition No. 656/1998. Students indulging in ragging in any form in the College Campus or in the vicinity will be strictly dealt with and punished as per the provisions of the Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act 1999.
- Playing with colours or any other material inside the College campus or in the vicinity or adjoining places outside the College campus during festivals is strictly forbidden. Students found indulging in such activity are liable for strict disciplinary action.
- Use of mobile phones in the College premises is prohibited. Strict action will be taken against students found violating this rule by confiscating their mobile phone as well as imposing a fine.

**Attendance:** Every student must complete, to the satisfaction of the Principal, the course of study prescribed for each term. The student must keep a minimum attendance of 75% of the working days in each term.

**Examination:** Attendance at the Unit, Terminal & Preliminary Examinations is compulsory. Absence at such examinations will render the student liable for not being sent up for the Board Examination.

The Management of St. John Junior College along with involvement of faculty and parents is committed to healthy discipline and high academic standards. Disobedience, misconduct, misbehaviour or failure to comply with the above rules and regulations and any other requirements, as notified from time to time, will result in the imposition of fines, loss of terms, suspension, dismissal or any other disciplinary action.
